But the Yukon is much more than snow locations – you'll find it adaptable, diverse and full of character.

Not to mention picture perfect.

The Yukon covers 483,450 square kilometres in the far northwestern part of mainland Canada.

The Yukon represents 4.8% of Canada's total land area. Its borders lie with British Columbia on the south (latitude 60 N), Northwest Territories on the east, and the U.S. state of Alaska on the west (longitude 141 W). In the north is the Beaufort Sea. All Yukon communities are south of the Arctic Circle and are accessible by road except for Old Crow which is a traditional native community 185 kilometres south of the Arctic coast.



## GETTING TO THE YUKON HAS NEVER BEEN EASIER!

**Air North**, Yukon's airline, has been in service since 1977 and is 100% owned by northerners. This local airline is becoming renowned for their legendary in-flight northern hospitality and complimentary light meals. They provide non-stop Boeing 737 jet service with departures from Calgary, Edmonton and Vancouver to Whitehorse.

In addition, Air North operates Hawker Siddeley 748 aircraft between Whitehorse and Dawson City, Old Crow, Inuvik, and Alaska.

**Air Canada**, offers seven days-a-week service between Whitehorse and Vancouver.

**Condor Airlines** will get you to Whitehorse from Frankfurt, Germany, between May and September.

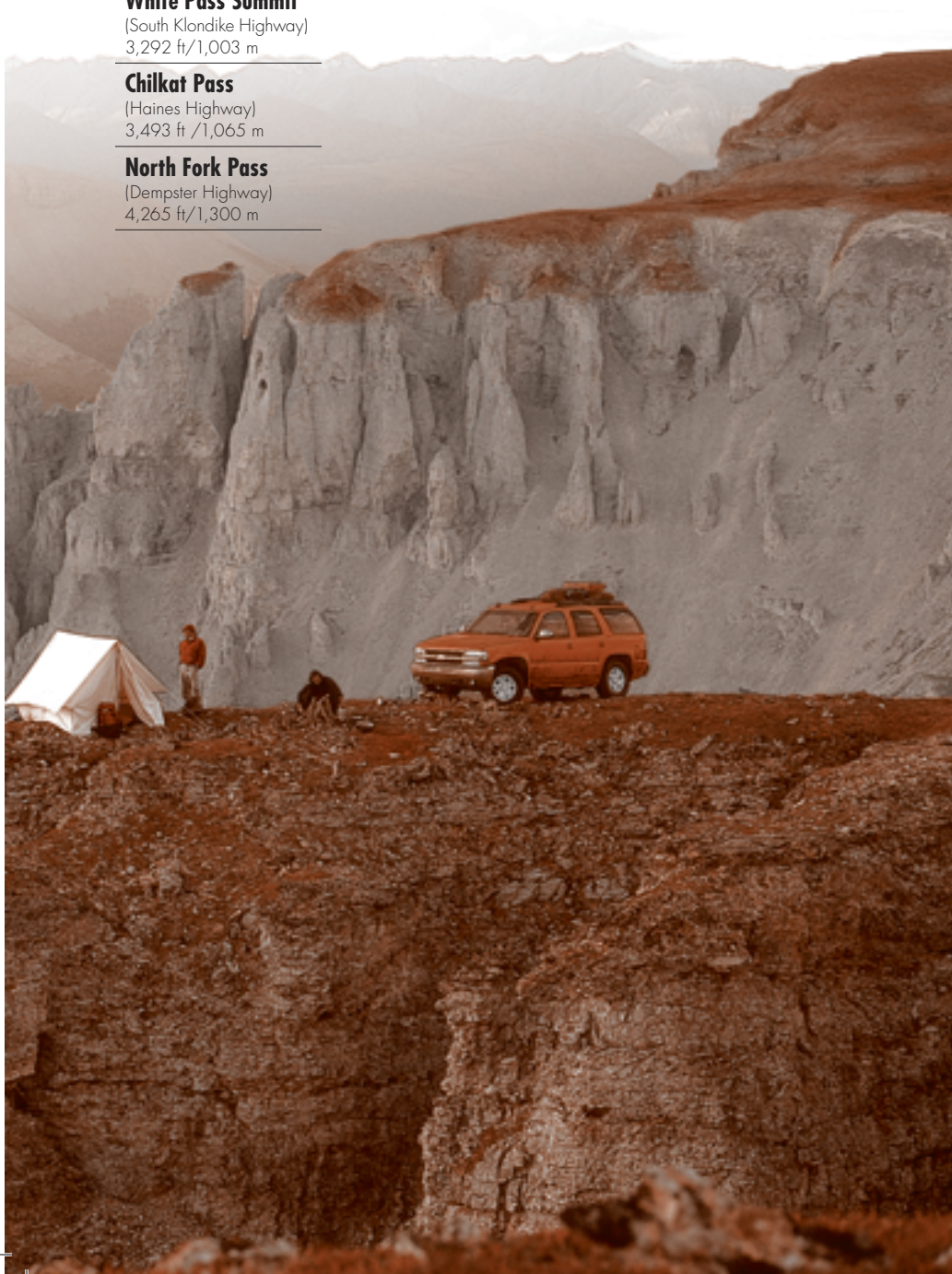

## STAY WARM!

**SHOOTING IN THE YUKON THIS WINTER? NO PROBLEM. WE'RE THE WORLD'S WINTER FILM EXPERTS! WE CANVASSED THE YUKON CREW AND CAME UP WITH THESE TIPS FOR STAYING WARM:**

**1. DRESS IN LAYERS:** That way you won't overheat when you're active, and you can easily add extra layers when you are standing around.

**2. AVOID WEARING COTTON:** Cotton is great summer wear because it helps to cool you off. It does the same thing in winter. Silk, wool, or fleece clothing will keep you warm. Add a windproof outer layer and you're set.

**3. IT IS MUCH EASIER TO STAY WARM THAN TO**

**WARM-UP:** A common mistake is to feel warm, take off clothes and

then get chilled. Keep your hat on, and keep taking those hot treats the craft service people are offering. On a really cold day it's not uncommon to eat a hot snack every hour.

**4. DON'T SKIMP ON YOUR BOOTS:** You'll be standing on snow and ice all day, so make sure you thoroughly insulate your feet. Buy the best quality boots you can; there is not a great increase in price when purchasing boots with higher insulation value. If you have boots with removable liners, don't forget to remove the liners every night to ensure they are completely dry for the next morning. Moisture draws heat from the body and for that reason wool or fabrics with a wicking property make the best socks in cold weather. Layers are good but don't forget to leave a bit of insulating air space in your boots; tight boots are cold boots. If you find you always have cold feet and hands, you probably need more layers around your body core.

**5. DEHYDRATION WILL CHILL YOU DOWN:** Working in our sometimes cold, dry climate can leave you parched. Take the teas and soups that are offered but try not to drink too much coffee or black teas, as they will dehydrate you.

Dress in layers.

Avoid wearing cotton.

It is much easier to stay warm than to warm-up.

Don't skimp on boots.

Dehydration will chill you down.

Bring your shades.

Buy locally.

Ask the locals!

## 6. BRING YOUR SHADES:

A sunny day on the snow is very bright. Use a high number sunblock and a brimmed hat.

**7. BUY LOCALLY:** Take advantage of the low Canadian dollar, no sales tax and a plethora of winter clothing stores in the Yukon. Our winter clothing prices on brand-name outerwear is priced about 20% lower than Vancouver and half of what

you would pay in California! Because winter's our strong suit, our stores are stuffed with down, fleece, wool and Gore-Tex®.

## 8. ASK THE LOCALS!

Remember we're the winter experts. Every one of us has a toasty comfort gem to offer.

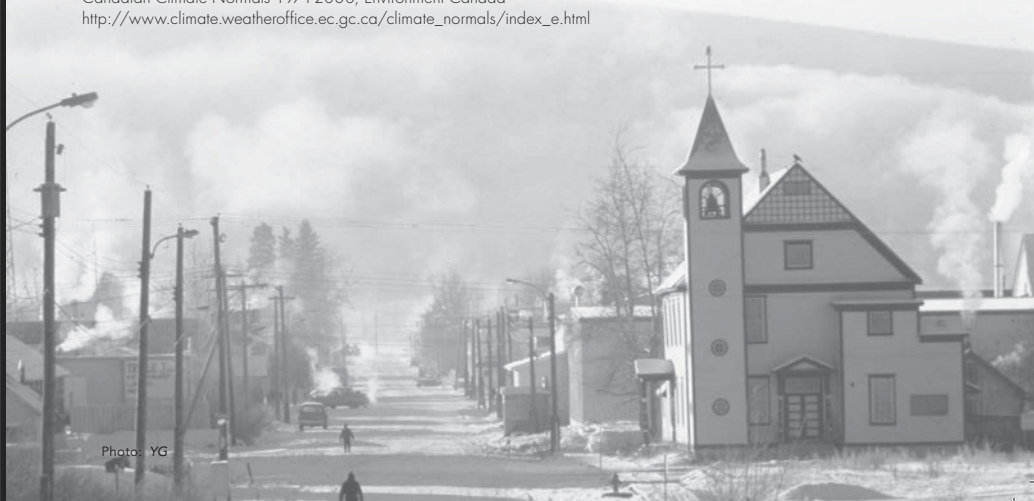

**HIRING NON-CANADIAN WORKERS FOR FILM AND TELEVISION CAN BE AN IMPORTANT PART OF MAKING A PRODUCTION IN CANADA. THE ENTRY OF FOREIGN WORKERS CAN ALSO BRING UNIQUE INTERNATIONAL TALENT TO CANADA.**

Anyone who is not a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident who wishes to work in Canada needs to be authorized to do so.

In most cases, employers hiring non-Canadian workers in film and television must get a *Human Resources and Skills Development Canada (HRSDC)* labour

market opinion (*LMO*). The non-Canadian worker also requires a *Citizenship and Immigration (CIC)* work permit to work in Canada. These work permits are issued at the Canadian visa offices abroad, or for U.S. residents, at ports of entry.

Film and television producers who wish to bring foreign workers to Yukon should contact the Citizenship and Immigration office in Vancouver.

Allow a four-week lead time for consultations between HRSDC, the film and television producers (employers), and the unions and guilds. There is a processing fee of \$150 for an employment authorization.

Crews of three or fewer coming to Canada for a period of less than three weeks, for Americans, and six weeks for other foreign film crews, to produce tourism promotions for non-Canadian audiences are exempt from employment validation, however, they are still required to obtain work permits at their point of entry to Canada.

## YUKON WORKERS' COMPENSATION BOARD

### IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT PRODUCTION COMPANIES UNDERSTAND WORKERS' COMPENSATION AND OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS BEFORE ARRIVING IN THE YUKON

There are also requirements for adjacent jurisdictions – British Columbia and the Northwest Territories.

Safety saves and safety pays. While it is your responsibility to comply with laws and regula-

tions, they are just the minimum standards. The best practice is to exceed safety regulations.

The Yukon places high importance on the safety of young workers. If you are hiring workers under 25, you are encouraged to become a Passport to Safety employer.

Go to [www.wcb.yk.ca](http://www.wcb.yk.ca) to find out more, or sign up at [www.passporttosafety.com](http://www.passporttosafety.com) and name the Yukon Workers' Compensation *Health and Safety Board (YWCHSB)* as your recruiter. The YWCHSB will help cover the costs, which are minimal.

### The following are general conditions:

- ▲ You must register with YWCHSB if:
  - △ You are an employer working in the Yukon for a total of 15 (or more) days in a calendar year
  - △ You are hiring Yukon workers
- ▲ If you are hiring Yukon workers to work in Atlin, B.C., or the White Pass, you will need to contact WorkSafe B.C. This is important for both workers' compensation coverage and occupational health and safety requirements.
- ▲ Because of remote locations used for filming, there are minimum standards in the Yukon for both First Aid equipment and the certification of First Aid people.

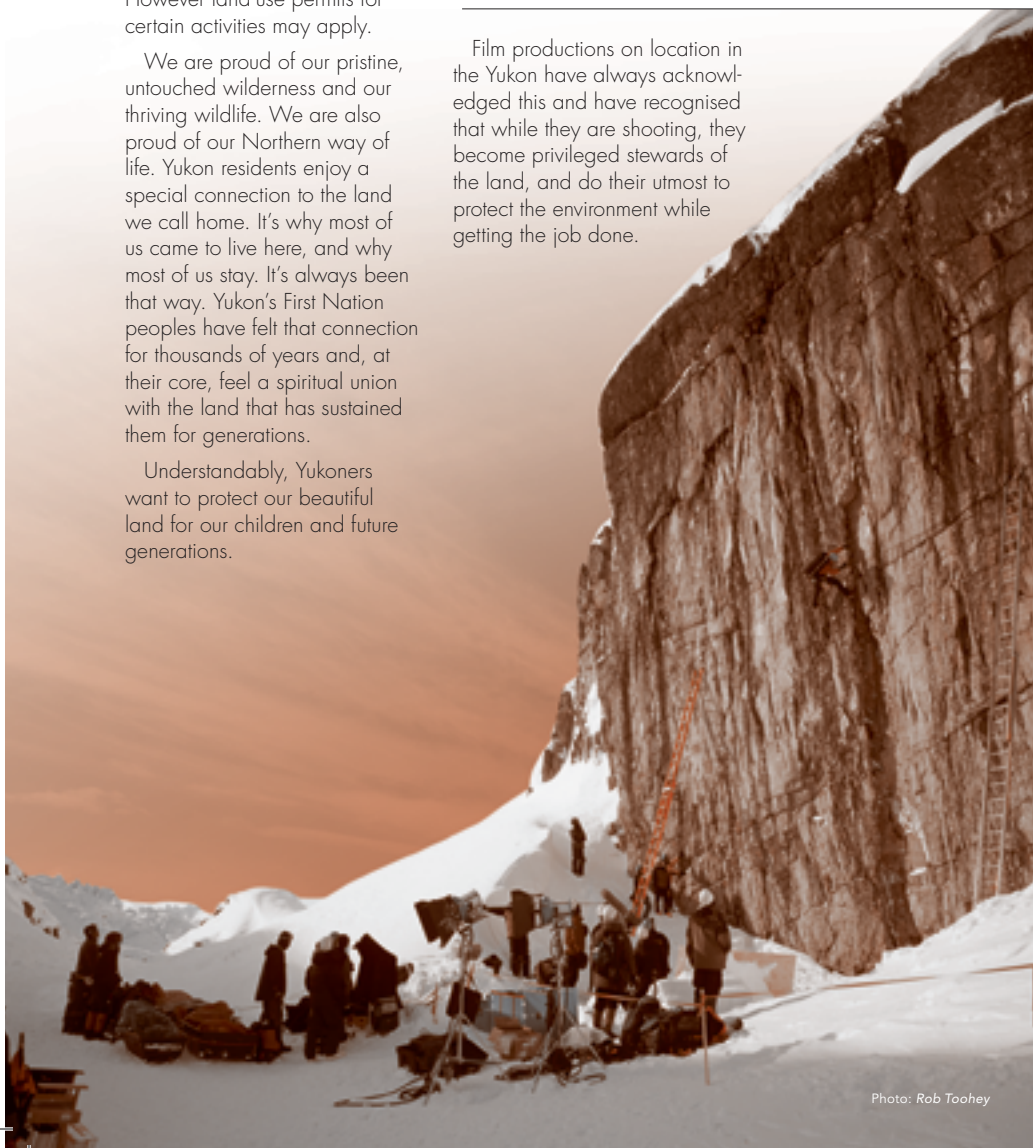

## TERRITORIAL PARKS

### **PARK PERMITS ARE REQUIRED FOR COMMERCIAL FILMING IN YUKON PARKS (INCLUDING CAMPGROUNDS).**

Regional Superintendents, located in Dawson City (Klondike Region), Carcross (Liard Region) and Haines Junction (Kluane Region) can review commercial filming applications and, when appropriate, authorize a park permit.

The Tombstone Park management plan, currently under negotiation between Yukon Government and Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in, has specific provisions for commercial filming in the park.

While the management plan is under negotiation, the TH Final Agreement legally binds Yukon Government to manage the park according to the park objectives contained in the final agreement. This includes the protection of the area's natural, historic and cultural resources.

The following areas have been designated territorial parks in Yukon:

- ▲ **TOMBSTONE TERRITORIAL PARK**
- ▲ **FISHING BRANCH ECOLOGICAL RESERVE & NI'IINLI'NJIK (FISHING BRANCH) WILDERNESS PRESERVE AND HABITAT PROTECTION AREA**
- ▲ **HERSCHEL ISLAND TERRITORIAL PARK**
- ▲ **COAL RIVER SPRINGS ECOLOGICAL RESERVE**

By receiving advance word of the basic details of proposed commercial filming activity, Yukon Parks in collaboration with the Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in First Nation can alert your film company of any special conditions such as areas or critical times to avoid.

More parks will be officially designated under First Nations Land Claims agreements in the future.

## FILMING IN AERODROMES AND AIRPORTS

**SECURITY AT YUKON AIRPORTS IS A HIGH-PRIORITY. IF YOU ARE CONSIDERING FILMING AT A YUKON AIRPORT OR AERODROME IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT YOU GET THE CLEARANCE AND/OR PERMISSION REQUIRED.**

To ensure all safety precautions and appropriate notices are provided to the regulatory agency, Transport Canada, you must contact the Government of Yukon, Department of Highways and Public Works, Aviation Branch, for a permit.

You will be required to secure a permit by entering into a Government of Yukon licence agreement for your activity and you must provide proof of insurance. The agreement covers your liability, explains the airport manager's control, and specifies how, when, where and who is permitted to occupy airport lands. Clearances to restricted areas are controlled through Transport Canada and are subject to a Canadian Security and Intelligence Service review.

Be sure to give yourself sufficient lead time as clearance can take between 30 days and 3 months depending on the nature of your activity and its location.

### HIGHWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY

In accordance with the Yukon Highways Act, persons or businesses that wish to perform activities within a highway Right-of-Way are required to apply for a permit.

▲ Highway Rights of Way are defined as the legal surveyed land/area set aside for highways and roads. This area extends beyond the traveled surface.

▲ Highways that are not maintained also require permits.

▲ The permitting process will involve an assessment of the area, work proposed and a review of safety concerns associated with the work.

▲ Permit applications can take from 4 to 6 weeks to process.

▲ Proof of insurance must be provided prior to approval. Applicants shall name the Government of Yukon as "Additional Insured" on their insurance policy.

Permit applications and further information can be obtained from the Government of Yukon website, or by contacting the Transportation Maintenance Branch.

## ELECTRICAL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

In advance of arriving in the Yukon Territory and prior to the start of production, it is essential that all incoming production companies understand the permit requirements for filming in the Yukon.

According to the Yukon Electrical Protection Act Regulations and the Canadian Electrical Code, there is a

requirement for procurement of an electrical permit.

It is the responsibility of the Production Company to investigate and comply with all necessary permitting regulations when filming in the Yukon.

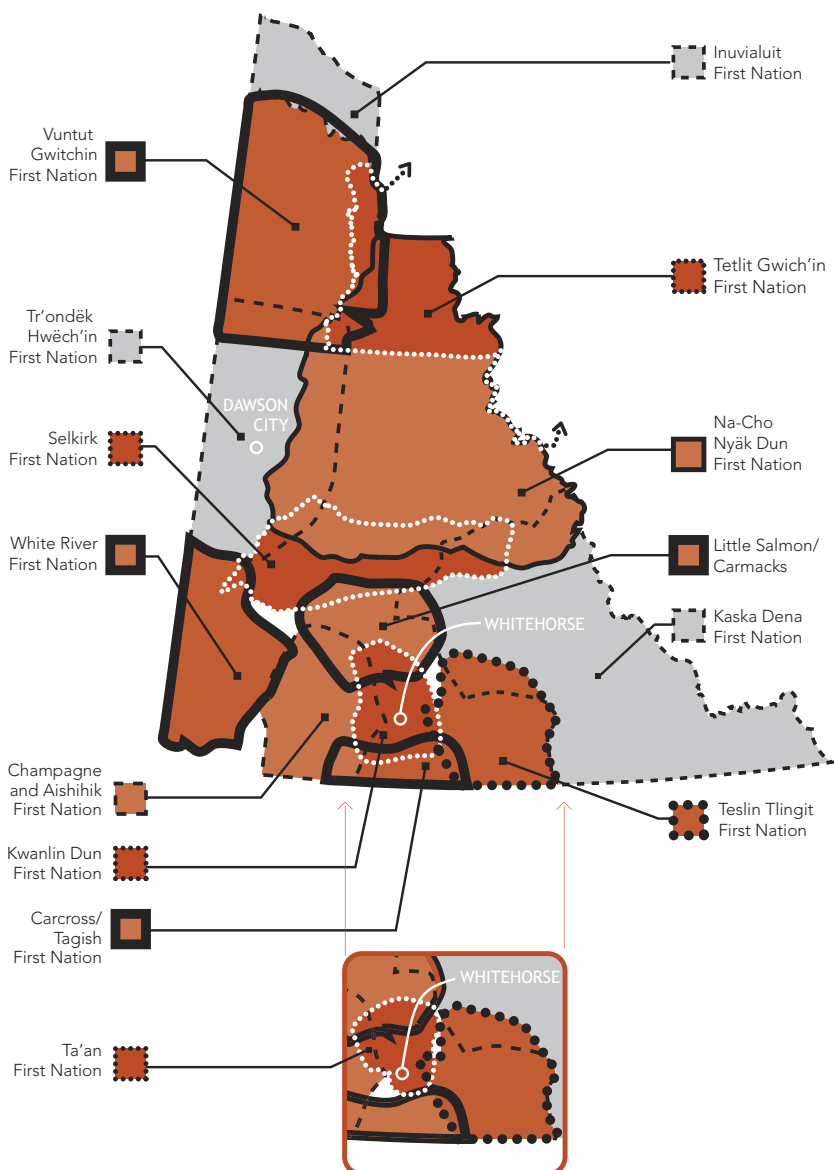

Failure to obtain the required permits may result in prosecution and penalties.

Steps in obtaining a permit are as follows:

**1. OBTAIN, COMPLETE AND SUBMIT** an "Application for a Permit to Export or Import Live Wildlife."

**2. SUBMIT THE COMPLETED APPLICATION FORM** with a health certificate regarding the animal(s) to be imported signed by the veterinarian who inspected the animal(s).

**3. WHEN THE COMPLETED** application and health certificate are received, an import permit can be issued for a period of up to 90 days.

**4. OBTAIN A WILDLIFE EXPORT PERMIT** to legally export the animal(s) from the Territory.

## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CAST AND CREW

### 1. BYLAW: As

a courtesy, when filming within any municipality in the Yukon, please contact the Manager of Bylaw Services or relevant authority to discuss your production requirements – i.e. parking, snow removal/addition, road closures etc.

### 2. NOTIFICATIONS:

When filming in a neighborhood or business district, proper notification is to be provided to each merchant or resident directly affected by filming activity (this includes parking, base camps and filming areas). The filming notice shall include:

- ▲ Name of Production Company
- ▲ Kind of Production (e.g. feature film, movie of the week, TV Pilot, series etc.)
- ▲ Type and duration, and description of activity (i.e. times, dates and number of days, including preparation and strike.)

**3. VEHICLES:** Production vehicles arriving on location in or near a residential neighborhood shall not enter the

area before the time stated in the Location Agreement.

Production vehicles shall park one by one, turning off engines as soon as possible.

Cast and crew vehicles shall observe designated parking areas noted by location managers. This shall appear on the call sheet map.

Filming may only take place during the times noted on

the Location Agreement. Please be aware that any filming within the City of Whitehorse may only occur between the hours of 7:00 AM and 11:00 PM. An extension of these hours require surveying the surrounding residents and receiving a majority approval (written where possible, name and address noted if home owner/tenant has no objection but does not wish to sign). Once a majority approval has been received, you must apply to the City Manager for an Extension. Other municipalities have similar bylaws.

**4. TOWING:** Moving or towing of any vehicle is prohibited without the express permission of the owner of the vehicle. If the vehicle is parked in violation, please contact the relevant authority to have it removed.

**5. PARKING:** It is up to the Film Company to make alternate parking arrangements for residents, whose parking is displaced by filming activity. Relocating vehicles by towing to accommodate filming or parking will not be permitted.

**6. DRIVEWAYS:** Production vehicles shall not block or park in driveways without the express permission of the driveway owner and/or Manager of By-Law Services.

**7. SIGNAGE:** Highly visible signage shall be posted if traffic (both pedestrian and vehicular) is being rerouted. All cables and similar items are to be channeled neatly and safely.

**8. TRESPASSING:** Cast and Crew shall not trespass on residents' or merchants' property. They must remain within the boundaries of the property that has been used for filming.

**9. ALCOHOL:** No beverages containing alcohol will be consumed on public property.

**10. MEALS:** Cast and crew meals shall be confined to the area designated in the location agreement. Individuals shall eat within their designated meal area. All trash must be disposed of properly upon completion of the meal. All catering, craft service, construction, strike and personal trash must be removed from the location, ensuring that all locations are returned to their original condition.

**11. SMOKING:** Cast and crew shall observe designated smoking area and always extinguish cigarettes in the appropriate containers.

**12. LANDSCAPE:** Removing, trimming and/or cutting of vegetation are prohibited unless approved in writing by the relevant authority, or property owner.

**13. STREET SIGNS:** Film crew shall not remove any street

signs without the expressed permission of the relevant authority. In some cases only municipal staff or the staff of Community and Transportation Services, Yukon Territorial Government, can do this.

**14. NOISE:** Every member of the cast and crew shall keep noise levels as low as possible at all times. Cast and crew will refrain from the use of lewd or improper language.

**15. CLOTHING:** Film company employees shall wear appropriate clothing while on location (i.e. t-shirts with offensive slogans or logos are not acceptable).

**16. PUBLIC DISPLAY:** Crew shall not display signs, posters or pictures on vehicles that members of the public may find offensive or objectionable (i.e. material containing vulgar language or sexual content).

**17. BADGES:** Every member of the crew shall wear a production pass (badge) when required by the location.

**18. PETS:** The cast and crew shall not bring guests or pets to the location, unless expressly authorized in advance by the Production Company.

**19. LOCAL LAWS:** The company will comply at all times with applicable federal and territorial and municipal laws while filming in the Yukon

The Production Company and General Public appreciate your cooperation and assistance in upholding the CODE OF CONDUCT.

We are offering these financial incentives to eligible productions:

### **1. FILM LOCATION INCENTIVE:**

- ▲ The Film Location Incentive encourages production companies from outside Yukon to film in Yukon and hire and train Yukoners. There are three components to this incentive program.

#### **Travel Rebate**

- ▲ Commercial and documentary productions are eligible for 50% of travel costs to a maximum of \$10,000 or 10% of all Yukon expenditures, whichever is the lesser.
- ▲ Television program, television movie (Movie of the Week), and feature film productions are eligible for 50% of travel costs to a maximum of \$15,000 or 15% of Yukon expenditures not assisted under any other portion of the Yukon Film Incentive Program, whichever is the lesser.

#### **Labour Rebate**

- ▲ Television programs, television movies (Movie of the Week), documentaries, and feature films (but not commercials) are eligible for a rebate of up to 35% of wages paid for eligible Yukon labour, provided criteria are met.

#### **Training Program**

- ▲ As with the Labour rebate, the production is eligible for a rebate of up to 35% of wages paid to individuals providing on-set training (techniques and equipment) to eligible Yukon labour.

### 2. FILM TRAINING INITIATIVE:

Up to \$3,000/person/year is available to Yukon residents training for a career in film. Applicants must have demonstrated a commitment to a career in this field (such as significant recent course work and/or work experience).

### 3. YUKON FILM-MAKERS FUND:

Up to \$5,000/applicant is available to Yukon resident film and video professionals to assist them in developing viable careers and businesses making films and videos for broadcast or commercial release. Two intakes per year – June 1st and December 1st.

### 4. FILM DEVELOPMENT FUND:

- ▲ Up to 50% of the actual Yukon expenditures to a maximum of \$35,000 or 33% of total project expenses (whichever is the lesser) can be available to Yukon residents or Yukon corporations to assist with the costs of development of film projects in Yukon. The applicant is required to have market place support in the form of either a broadcast development agreement, or a distribution arrangement.
- ▲ An additional \$10,000 may be available to an applicant if the broadcaster/distributor requires more senior personnel not available in Yukon to be attached to the project.

### 5. FILM PRODUCTION FUND:

- ▲ Up to \$500,000/project is available to Yukon corporations who financially and creatively control projects to assist with the costs of producing a film in Yukon.  
The applicant is required to have marketplace support in the form of a broadcast license which is a commitment by a licensed broadcaster to participate financially in the production of the project, or a distribution arrangement.
- ▲ For productions solely controlled by a Yukon resident or corporation, the contributions will be based on 30% of Yukon expenditures or 30% of total production costs whichever is the lesser.
- ▲ For co-productions the contribution will be based on 30% of Yukon expenditures or 20% of total production costs whichever is lesser.

**THE YUKON SOUND RECORDING PROGRAM WAS PUT IN PLACE TO SUPPORT THE YUKON RECORDING INDUSTRY,** to further develop the cultural industries sector, and to encourage a business focus among those in the Yukon music industry. This program assists Yukon sound recording professionals in developing viable careers and businesses.

▲ **THE APPLICANT MUST** be a Yukon resident or a Yukon business.

▲ **THE APPLICANT MAY BE:**

- ▲ A Yukon sound recording artist,
- ▲ Owner of a Yukon sound recording studio,
- ▲ Owner of a Yukon sound recording label.

▲ **FOR ARTIST APPLICATIONS,** for duos or groups, a minimum 50% must meet the above Yukon residency requirements.

▲ **FOR STUDIO AND LABEL APPLICATIONS,** consideration will be given to projects involving non-Yukon artists if the project can demonstrate benefits to the development of the Yukon sound recording industry.

▲ **THERE ARE TWO INTAKES PER YEAR:** May 1 and Nov 1

There are two components to the Sound Recording Program:

▲ **PROFESSIONAL DEMO RECORDING**

▲ **UP TO \$2,000** for producing a CD with a minimum of 2 tracks or 5 minutes.

▲ **PROFESSIONAL SOUND RECORDING**

▲ **UP TO \$5,000** for producing a CD with a minimum of 6 tracks or 20 minutes.

### CANADIAN FILM OR VIDEO PRODUCTION TAX CREDIT (CPTC)

The objective of the CPTC is to encourage Canadian programming and to develop an active domestic production sector. This fully refundable credit is available at the rate of 25% of the **qualified labour expenditure (QLE)** of an eligible production.

CPTC Guidelines and Application Forms are available to enable producers to apply for a Canadian film or video production certificate (Part A) and a Certificate of Completion (Part B). The relevant sections of the Income Tax Act and Regulations take precedence over these Guidelines. Certification is required to claim the tax credit.

### FILM OR VIDEO PRODUCTION SERVICES TAX CREDIT (PSTC)

The PSTC is designed to enhance Canada as a location of choice for film and video productions employing talented Canadians as well as strengthen the industry and secure investment. The PSTC is available as a percentage of qualified Canadian labour expenditures.

PSTC Guidelines and Application Forms are available to assist applicants in obtaining an accredited film or video production certificate (Accreditation Certificate). The Draft Amendments concerning the Film or Video Production Services Tax Credit take precedence over these Guidelines.

### GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

The Yukon does NOT have a provincial sales tax, however all of Canada has the **Goods and Services Tax (GST)**.

GST is a federal tax that applies at a rate of 6% to most goods and services bought in Canada. GST is charged by the supplier and is refundable from the Canada Revenue Agency.

Producers need to register for a GST number in order to receive a refund of the GST they

have paid to their suppliers. Your GST return should be filed monthly to obtain your refund on a timely basis.

GST on meals and entertainment may be refundable on 50% of your purchases. This applies to catering.
